Translation of Cedar City Symbols, by Jose Davila

Hack a straight path eastward, along the face of the rock, 864 cubits, searching on the center summit for a cap rock which covers an old mine and a burial ground of the ancients, where men women and children are buried. Take a ladder and go to the bottom of the hole, then go 64 cubits, breaking down the side wall which enters you into a room where there are records 1 aid away to the Lord.

According to Jose Davila translation a cubit is the value of 20.5 inches , 170'8" to a 100 cubits.
